NC FCCLA has set forth a mandatory dress code policy for the State Leadership Conference. Please review the policy before attending to ensure you and your students do not miss out on any sessions.

The NC FCCLA official dress is worn for the NC FCCLA activities per the dress code as outlined. The attire that is selected by the student is a personal choice as long as the NC FCCLA guidelines are followed.

MANDATORY ATTIRE FOR ALL SESSIONS | ENTIRE CONFERENCE AREA

- Red, black, or white polo or button-up shirt.
- Black or khaki pants.
- Black or khaki skirt or dress (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee).
- Dress shoes or flats, no tennis shoes. (Black preferred.)
- Jeans, t-shirts, athletic wear are NOT acceptable.

Note that the official red blazer is not required at the state level.

ADVISERS / CHAPERONES / ADULT GUESTS

- Business professional.
- Jeans, t-shirts, athletic wear are NOT acceptable.
